- Summary.** The collection contains materials gathered for Chandler's landscape architecture thesis analyzing one-hundred ninety identified residences in Spanish Town, the oldest neighborhood in Baton Rouge, La. (established 1805). The thesis was completed in 1985. The materials consist of completed and uncompleted questionnaires used to survey residents, audio tapes of interview with residents, color photographic prints and negatives of the residences, black & white photographic negatives and contact sheets, and black & white photographic prints used as illustrations in the thesis. Printed materials include items created for an exhibition associated with the thesis, three Spanish Town newsletters, and a "presentation copy" of the thesis itself.

BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

Spanish Town was commissioned in 1805. According to the Baton Rouge *State Times* (Oct. 18, 1980) "When Galvez Town, twenty miles southeast of Baton Rouge, was ceded in the Louisiana Purchase to the United States in 1803, the Canary Islanders who lived there asked to come to Baton Rouge in order to continue living on Spanish soil. In 1805, Don Carlos de Grandpré (Charles Grandpré), governor of West Florida, drew up the layout of an area east of the fort 'out of cannon shot' that became known as Spanish Town."

Spanish Town is considered the oldest neighborhood in Baton Rouge and was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1978. The oldest structure in Spanish Town is the Pino House (built 1823). As of 2011, the newest building was constructed in 1975.

In 1983 Thomas Chandler began collecting information for his Landscape Architecture thesis. In the abstract of his thesis *Spanish Town : Neighborhood as Place* (LSU call number 378.76 L930 1985 CHAN) Chandler states:

"The contemporary American scene is characterized by a disparity between environmental design and the ordinary landscape, resulting in ill-defined places with little discernible meaning. This study seeks to understand an existing place, one rich with meaning, and to communicate its character, thus raising our consciousness of place and perhaps pointing towards a better environment."

Chandler's thesis was submitted to the Graduate Faculty of the Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College in partial fulfillment of the requirements for the degree of Master of Landscape Architecture in 1985.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection contains materials gathered for Chandler's landscape architecture thesis analyzing one-hundred ninety identified residences in Spanish Town, the oldest neighborhood in Baton Rouge, La. (established 1805). The thesis was completed in 1985. The materials consist of completed and uncompleted questionnaires used to survey residents, audio tapes of interview with residents, color photographic prints and negatives of the residences, black & white photographic negatives and contact sheets, and black & white photographic prints used as illustrations in the thesis.. Printed materials include items created for an exhibition associated with the thesis, three Spanish Town newsletters, and a "presentation copy" of the thesis itself.

SERIES DESCRIPTIONS**Series I. Surveys, 1983**

Each residence in the thesis study area received a standard survey, to be completed by the residents at that address. Included in the collection are twelve (12) largely unidentified surveys that were not used in Chandler's analysis and one hundred ninety (190) completed surveys associated with addresses. Most of the surveys indicated as "missing" from addresses in this series were physically pasted into the personal copy of the thesis and copied to be published in the printed copy of the thesis; these "missing" surveys may be read there.

Series II. Audio tape recordings, 1984

From the one hundred ninety (190) addresses included in the surveys, the residents of twenty-three (23) of the dwellings were selected for an audio interview / history. Of these, twenty (20) were selected for the final thesis.

FOR REASONS OF PRESERVATION THESE AUDIO TAPES ARE CURRENTLY RESTRICTED. If staffing permits, digital copies of the tape can be made as needed for patron use, but a minimum of two weeks' notice is required.

Series III. Photographic prints, 1984**Subseries A, Black and white photographic contact sheets, 1984**

Contact sheets were created from the black & white negatives in the collection. The negatives were originally created to document the twenty (20) sites included in the published thesis. The author created as few as sixty-one (61) and as many as one hundred forty (140) images for each of the sites published in the thesis. Of these images, four (4) were selected to accompany each of the twenty addresses used in the thesis.

In addition, the author created a general "Spanish Town" image set containing five hundred eighty-six (586) images covering a range of subjects including general street scenes, specific buildings within the study area, and the Spanish Town Mardi Gras Parade and street party. Only six (6) of these images were published in the thesis.

Subseries B, Color photographic prints, 1984

Upon receipt of the collection, each of the Spanish Town addresses in the thesis study area had a color photograph of the exterior of the building at that address attached to an envelope that contained the survey for that address. For preservation reasons, these images have been separated from the original envelopes, rehoused, and identified with its Spanish Town street address to maintain the intellectual connection between the survey and the image for each address.

Series IV. Photographic negatives, 1984**Subseries A, Black & white photographic negatives, 1984**

A series of black & white photographs were created for each of the twenty (20) residences included in the thesis. Of these, four (4) images were selected to accompany the thesis text for each address. There are more than four exposures for each address.

As above, the author created a general "Spanish Town" image series. Of these five hundred eighty-six (586) images only six (6) were published in the thesis.

Subseries B, Color photographic negatives, 1984

A color photograph was taken of the exterior of the building(s) at each of the addresses in the thesis study area. These negatives consist of eight (8) rolls of film, two processed on or about 1983 September 07 and the remaining six processed on or about 1984 September 03. A print of the building(s) at each of the addresses was attached to the survey documents. There may be more than one exposure for each of the addresses.

Subseries A, Exhibition materials. 1985

An exhibition announcement and a map of sites included in the thesis and the exhibition “Spanish Town: Neighborhood as Place” were created for that exhibition.

Subseries B, Spanish Town Newsletters, 1984

Two (2) newsletters from Spanish Town organizations published in 1984 during the thesis study. One newsletter was published by the Mystic Krewe for the Preservation of Lagniappe in Louisiana, Inc. There are two copies of the *Historic Spanish Town Neighborhood Happenings*; vol. 1, no. 1, one of the copies includes a holographic note.

Series VI, Thesis, 1985

This personal copy of the thesis is a spiral-bound “album” containing original copies of the surveys, additional text, black & white photographic prints related to each of the twenty (20) sites included in the thesis, and six (6) black & white photographic prints related to Spanish Town as a whole.
