### **BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE**

Charles W. Bosch served as the Executive Secretary of the Louisiana Wildlife Federation (1951-1973) and later worked for the National Wildlife Federation as a coordinator for fundraising, lobbying, and other efforts on behalf of wildlife federations in individual states. In the late 1970s, Bosch was awarded the Nash award, a prize given to professional conservationists for outstanding work on behalf of America's wildlife and natural resources.

### **SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE**

The Charles W. Bosch papers consist of published journals, government reports, periodicals, and various other printed materials related to wildlife conservation, while correspondence documents Bosch's work in both the Louisiana and National Wildlife Federations. Also included are organizational records of the Louisiana Wildlife Federation as well as job-related organizational records of the National Wildlife Federation.
